



ORDER

In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 RAMABAI NAVRANGE, JUNIOR COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, OPP.GAMADAVI TELEPHONE EXCHANGE GRANT ROAD WEST, MUMBAI had submitted an application to the Western Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting D.Ed. of two-year from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 120 students 40 in each of three divisions.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- (i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- (ii) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- (iii) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs.3.00 lakhs.
- (iv) The institution has initiated the process for recruitment of Principal/Head of Department and teachers for the said course.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to RAMABAI NAVRANGE, JUNIOR COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, OPP.GAMADAVI TELEPHONE EXCHANGE GRANT ROAD WEST, MUMBAI for D.Ed. of two-year from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 120 students 40 in each of three divisions subject to fulfillment of the following.

- (a) The institution shall ensure that it gets duly affiliated for this course to the concerned Board/Directorate and all other formalities required by the Board/Directorate are also completed before the commencement of the course and admission of the students to the course and a report to this effect should be sent to the Committee.
- (b) That the institution will ensure that 06 (one Principal and 05 lecturers) faculty members are in position for an intake of 50 students or less before commencement of the course and a report to this effect duly verified by the Director of the concerned SCERT shall be sent to the Committee within one month of commencement of the course. For intake of students in excess of the prescribed unit, the number of full time teachers shall be increased proportionately.
- (c) The institution shall within one month of the receipt of recognition create an endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- (d) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (In case the course is started in rented premises).
- (e) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards as prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

4. Recognition is subject to the condition that the Board/Directorate shall ensure that, among other things, an institution has appointed required number of faculty members (including Principal/Head of Department) as per the norms of the NCTE/State Government.
5. Further, the recognition is subject to the fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government, etc.
6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating university/State Directorate of Education to the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.



Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your attention to Sub-clause 6 of Clause 7 of the National Council for Teacher Education (recognition, norms and procedure) Regulation, 2005, prescribing therein *interalia* launching of a website by the teacher education.

2. It is felt that website is not only necessary for the new applicants for providing information for processing of the applications but even the institutions already recognized by the NCTE should also have their own website as the website would provide essential information relating to the institution to all stake holders particularly to the students desirous of taking admission in the institution, for taking an informed decision before joining the course applied for. It is, therefore, requested that immediate action may please be taken to ensure that the web-site of the institution is available to the general public latest by 31st July, 2006.

3. It is necessary that the website contain all relevant information which should be up-to-date and authentic. Though you are free to decide about the content and the design of the web-site keeping in view of the above objectives yet to ensure that the web-site is user friendly and provide all necessary information, it should contain atleast the following information invariably:-

(i) Information about the institution

Name and complete address of the institution, name and complete address of the Principal, date of establishment, date of recognition by NCTE, details of courses offered with approved intake.

(ii) Information about Management

Complete details of Management and its office bearers, registered address, telephone numbers etc. and the names and details of other institutions run by the Management.

(iii) Information on faculty

Complete details including addresses of the faculty, their educational and professional qualifications, whether or not NET/SLET passed, salary paid, etc.

- (iv) Infrastructural availability
- (v) Information about hostel
- (vi) Information on subjects/specialization offered
- (vii) Fee structure both for free/payment seats with break up
- (viii) Admission procedure, name of the affiliating university, dates of start/end of the academic session.
- (ix) Information on the results
- (x) Information about the placement cell, if any.
- (xi) Performance Appraisal Report (PAR)
- (xii) Latest audit statements of account.

4. It may please be noted that as per the conditions for grant of recognition by the NCTE, a recognized institution is required to comply with the revised norms and standard and other conditions prescribed by the NCTE. It is, therefore, requested that necessary action for creation of the web-site of your institution may be taken immediately. Any inaction or non-compliance of the letter shall be treated as violation of the terms and condition of the recognition resulting in appropriate action against the defaulters.
